Background and Experience	
Please briefly present the partner organisation.	<p>In its 119-year history, the GIB Sports Society has already produced a rich sports story of success. Along with all traditions and voluntary work, today the modern organized sports society GIB is recognizable in the narrower and wider Slovene territory, both with programs for sports recreation from 9 months to 100 years old and with programs of high quality sports, for the fields of women's artistic gymnastics and judo.</p> <p>The company with more than 1500 members has 12 employees and over forty amateur instructors and trainers who are covering 36 different sport programmes. In addition to competitors, we also have our own international judges and other officials in judo and gymnastics. The Society is one of the largest in Slovenia.</p> <p>Sports society GIB covers almost 5000 m2 of covered surfaces (8 sports halls) and 1500 m2 of outdoor sports surfaces. We are introducing modern sports programs with enthusiasm. We follow the modern guidelines of sports offer, therefore we are introducing new, modern programmes. In addition to the standard programs, we have many development projects that are also linked to partnerships outside of our society.</p> <p>We are cooperating with Ljubljana's Sports Association, Faculty of sport, different schools and pre-schools in Ljubljana, Judo association of Slovenia, Gymnastics association of Slovenia and the Olympic Committee of Slovenia.</p>

Olympic Committee of Slovenia gave us the name of the regional society for judo and women's artistic and rhythmic gymnastics.

We are also managing Association for sports recreation of Slovenia which brings together 25 societies. Association for sports recreation of Slovenia carries out 6 national projects in sport recreation.

We raise young athletes, we raise competitive sport for judo and women's artistic gymnastics and we take care for a healthy adult and old age.

As the social flag symbolically describes "Movement is life, life is movement", that is precisely the content that we write out every day in our practice.

Despite the fact that our activity is very international, we have been in the Erasmus + Sport program only since 2019. We want to enrich our offer and contribute to EU policy. With our knowledge, experience, staff and equipment, we are ready and able to carry out an EU project. We were successful in the Erasmus + Sport call

ERASMUS+ SPORT PROJECTS

Športno društvo GIB has successfully applied as beneficiary with first Erasmus+ Sport Small Collaborative Partnership in 2019, named JITA KYOEI – mutual welfare and benefit. We are also partner in the Erasmus+ Sport Collaborative Partnership – EU on the move, which started in 2020. In 2020 we successfully applied with our first big project SONKEI – Respect in sport, respect in life (Collaborative partnership) and we are also partners in small CP project called Movimente – move better, learn better.

Jita Kyoei – mutual welfare and benefit

The aim of the project is to implement the concept Jita Kyoei into the society through the use of sport, notably judo. The concept Jita Kyoei was devised by founder of judo Jigoro Kano. Jita Kyoei means mutual prosperity for self and others. In the words of Jigoro Kano, it teaches us that each member of society and the groups organized within must function in harmony and cooperation with others. Nothing is more important than living prosperously together. In today's world of multiculturalism and different world views, is getting ever more important to respect each other and accept our differences. Sport and judo in particular, can be a great tool to achieve this goal. Through the project we will devise the practical learning modules for: - Implementation of Jita Kyoei into regular judo practice in judo clubs- The use of specific judo methods of training in schools and different educational institutions to promote Jita Kyoei. We want to cooperate with judo societies from different countries with different backgrounds, so we can achieve this global aim: - to connect sport societies from different environment and cultures, with different experiences with multiculturalism and social inclusion for the purpose of developing learning methodology to promote judo values;- to present the result of the project to our parent organizations (national judo federations, European judo federation) with the intention to internationalise developed learning methodology to promote judo values. We will present the project and the results in the international environment; - with our cooperation we want to prove that the project itself is the communicator of Jita Kyoei and other judo values.

Sonkei – Respect in sport, respect in life

The topic we have chosen for our project is: »Combat violence and tackle racism, discrimination and intolerance in sport«. We are aware that the problem of violence and intolerance in sport is not properly addressed in our communities, so we want to make a difference. In our local environments, the violence in sport is practically a taboo subject. We have only very limited number of reports and researches about these problems in our country, but according to the reports from other EU countries and other countries around the world, the violence in sport must be also present in our countries. Our aim is to prevent violence and intolerance in sport through education and promotion of values of respect, courage, gender equality, inclusion and non-violence. By doing this we intend to change the mind sets of people and initiate social change that will provide safer environment for everyone. The project consortium consists out of 8 participating institutions from 8 different countries. The project aims and objectives will be achieved through the implementation of 9 work packages. We followed the Waterfall methodology model. There are six main phases in the design of the project: Planning, Analysis, Preparation of the outputs, Implementation, Evaluation and modification of the outputs and dissemination. We can conclude that we must make more effort to educate people about the problem of violence and intolerance in sport and to implement practical strategies in grassroots sport organizations. With our project we will educate and inform sport professionals how to tackle the problem of violence and intolerance in sport in grassroots sport organizations and raise the awareness of violence in sport and violence in general in our societies.

At our Sport Society we have interest to enrich our standard programmes with projects based on HEPA, Youth sport and exchange, Youth/Adult/Senior recreation, Inclusion for disabled people in our programmes (physical disabled kids), or any field of Erasmus+ that we can contribute in.
